This exposed them to a higher level of competition & they reached the semi-finals.

Objectives for 2015-2016:

- to continue with teacher CPD to ensure good quality PE is taught throughout the school so all pupils improve their health, skills and physical literacy. This will include more observation by the PE co-

ordinator of staff to establish that the support received in the last two years is sustainable.

- to use outside providers to work alongside teachers in cricket, multi-skills & dance to further assist with teacher confidence in delivering PE.
- to further increase the range of sports & clubs available to children & increase participation levels, whether attending a school club, taking part in a house competition or representing the school in inter school (level 2) competitions.
- to promote healthy & active lifestyles for all by targeting the least active & providing interventions through a Change for Life club.
- to use PE to raise attainment in other subjects, especially Maths.
