Sports Coach	£5320	Teacher CPD. To increase confidence, knowledge & skills of all staff in delivering PE & sport. To provide extra activities outside of curriculum. To support Change4Life children.	Confidence and knowledge in staff PE delivery has increased. Members of staff have assisted the PE Co-ordinator in running clubs in rounders, athletics and netball. Over thirty children each week take part in extra activities. Change4Life has targeted those children who do not participate in extra activities in school (outside of curriculum PE) to promote an active, healthy lifestyle.
Cover for PE Co-ordinator for sports hour for gifted & talented children	£1295	To provide opportunities for able & motivated children who have a strength in sport to develop their skills & awareness of fitness, team work & of game understanding for a variety of sports.	Over 30 children from three year groups experienced expert coaching throughout the year which helped develop & extend their talents. The children enjoyed the sessions immensely & they all represented their house, school & local clubs on many occasions. Parents also reported their child's enthusiasm & appreciation of the sessions.
After school netball club - Jackie Bright	£485	To provide extra provision for netball free of charge for the children to receive expert coaching.	Skills and confidence improved resulting in more interest in netball and the school team winning their league competition and annual tournament, progressing onto area finals.
Cover for staff for various sporting events	£583	To enable children to compete in level 2 competition.	81 children (56%) represented the school in matches and competitions in a variety of sports. A, B & even C teams were regularly fielded & many children represented the school for the first time.

Purchase of Quick sticks hockey balls (Olympic Legacy); netball bibs; cricket kit	£173	To replace & add to sports kit & equipment.	Children able to practise with appropriate equipment to enhance skills and enjoyment and wear smart kit when representing the school.
Sailing at Olympic Venue, Weymouth	£2300	To experience a sport many would not have the opportunity to take part in - Olympic legacy.	Year 6 children enjoyed taking part in sailing activities at the Olympic Sailing venue in Weymouth as part of their activity-based residential.
Somerset Cricket Board Affiliation Chance to Shine & Coaching Sessions	£25 (affiliation) + £60 (coaching)	Teacher CPD - Somerset County Cricket coach (linked to Long Sutton Cricket Club) works alongside teachers delivering PE lessons & a lunch time club. To gain confidence in & improve the quality of cricket delivery & related skills in the curriculum.	There has been an increase in teacher confidence in delivering cricket & lunchtime cricket clubs - year 3/4, year 5/6 boys & year 5/6 girls - have continued. Four classes - over 100 children - received quality cricket coaching throughout the Summer term. The year 5/6 team finished runners-up in the CLP competition this year & progressed to the area final. A & B teams & a girls' team played regular matches against other schools. Long Sutton CC continue to benefit from King Ina children joining their club.

Our Maths SATs result was 15% above the national average & children have commented that they really enjoy these type of maths lessons.

Tony Pryce Sports Voucher	£10	Sportsperson of the Year Award	A year 6 pupil who has made a huge contribution in a sporting context in their time at the school is given this award at the final school assembly. This is a prestigious award which is greatly coveted & inspires the younger pupils in the school.
Country Dancing outfits	£140	To support after school club and participation at schools festival held annually at Wells Cathedral.	Encourage participation in extracurricular activity. To promote active healthy lifestyle.
Trophy engraving	£56	To celebrate our sporting success.	Massive efforts from our teams this year resulted in rugby, football, netball, cricket and athletics competitions, leagues and tournaments being won. The children are hugely proud to receive these trophies which are awarded in achievement assemblies and displayed in school and are inspirational for all the children.

Over 20 children enjoyed a day at Somerset Cricket ground watching international cricket & taking part in various cricket activities around the ground. This helped to further their understanding & enjoyment of cricket as a healthy activity to pursue.
