What have we been up to?

All of the children across the Academy have settled in really well this term and have made a great start to the new school year. Our Reception children are now in school full time and it has been fantastic to welcome them to our school family.

The Infant children have started their Autumn Term History topic 'Time Traveller' where they are learning about the development of toys through time. They took part in a toy workshop earlier this month to kick start their learning.



The Junior children have also started their Autumn Term History topic 'Ancient Legacies' and are learning about the Egyptians. They began their learning with a trip to the Tutankhamun Museum in Dorchester.

We have once again started our Archie Project, the intergenerational project that brings together children in Kestrels and Merlins classes with members of the local community with dementia. The children visit Immacolata House every other week and we have already welcomed some of the residents to school to spend time with the children.
