Covid-19 Update

You will be aware that we have seen a sharp rise in positive cases of Covid-19 in school over the last couple of weeks, which is reflective of the situation within the wider community. I wish to assure you that our risk assessments are kept under close review and we are applying the procedures from within our Outbreak Management Plan, to try to limit the spread of the virus. We have held collective worship outside in the fresh air and some classes are playing in designated areas and eating lunch in their classrooms, while the cases in their classes remain high. These measures are reviewed regularly and will be relaxed as soon as the case numbers fall in the relevant class/es.
