Dear Parents,

This term we are studying the Tudors in history and as part of that topic we would like to take the children to Montacute House near Yeovil for a Tudor experience.

During the day, the children will have a one hour guided tour of the Tudor house and then take part in 'hands-on' activities to do with Tudor life which will be chosen from lavender bags, writing with quills, designing shields, examining artefacts and portraits and looking at Tudor clothing. This will give the children a real insight and understanding of what some aspects of life would have been like in Tudor times and the importance of portraits. The children will also have time to take part in sketching portraits in the Long Gallery and studying Tudor architecture and gardens outside.

The dates of the visit are as follows and we will be leaving school at 9am and arriving back before the end of the school day:

Friday 21st September 2018 - Year Two
