Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you are all well and that you have been enjoying the beautiful weather.

I write with further details about our end of year arrangements, including transition in preparation for September 2020.

**Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July:** Current Year 2 parents will be informed of their child's Year 3 class and teacher for September. The Year 2 children will be invited to visit the Junior site to meet their new teacher on either 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> July on the school playground for a short time during the morning, adhering to the social distancing rules. We will confirm which new teacher meeting your child is invited to attend next week.

**Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July:** All other parents will be informed of their child/ren's classes and teachers for September. On the same day, we will upload a video tour of each school site to our website, including video tours of individual classrooms filmed by the class teachers.

We will be unable to hold our usual new parents' evening for parents of children new to Reception and Year 3. Instead we will upload presentations to our website for parents to view on **6<sup>th</sup> July**. **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July:** The children will receive a welcome letter from their new teachers for September via email sent to those with parental responsibility for the child. The letter will invite the children to complete some work, which can be returned to school either by email or post. Year 2 children starting at the Junior site in September will be given their welcome letter in person, by their teacher, when they visit the Junior site on 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> July.

**Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July:** Year 6 children will take part in a Leavers' picnic on the sports field during the afternoon. Details of this event will follow.

**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July:** We would like to say goodbye to all children in their current classes before the summer holiday. Each class will be invited to visit school at an allocated time on 15<sup>th</sup> July. They will spend approx. 45 minutes on the school playground, at a safe distance from each other, with their class and teacher for one last time. I will write with timings for each class session next week.

I wish to remind you that Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June is an INSET day and children will have a break from work on schools on this day.
