


There are lots of ways you can enhance your child's learning at home!



Reading - Please remember to read with your child at least three times a week. Each book should be read three times to support fluency, confidence and comprehension. Please complete the home weekly reading record sheet when you read with your child and return it to school on a **Friday**.

Spellings – Please remember to practise your child's spellings each week ready for their spelling check in school on a Monday. You can find the spelling list they currently need to practise written at the bottom of the school reading feedback form. This will come home to you on a Monday. Spelling lists can be found on eSchools.

Tapestry – Please remember we upload observations of your child's learning in school to their Tapestry online learning journal. We love to see the children's learning at home too. Please feel free to upload photos or videos showing your child's learning at home. 😊

- Creating animal pictures using art apps


Literacy: Writing

Within 'Sun, Sea and Sand' we will explore a variety of stories such as 'George the Sun Safe Superstar', 'Commotion in the Ocean', 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' and 'Sharing a Shell'.

Within both of these topics we will also use non-fiction books to support our learning.
