As part of our charity work this year, we would like to support the work of Farm Africa; a charity that works directly with rural communities in Africa, helping them to produce more food by farming more effectively. Their aim is to build a future free from hunger and to help with the costs of schooling for children in Africa.

On Wednesday 3rd October, all children in the Academy will take part in a 'Great African Welly Walk' around Somerton, to raise awareness of Farm Africa.
